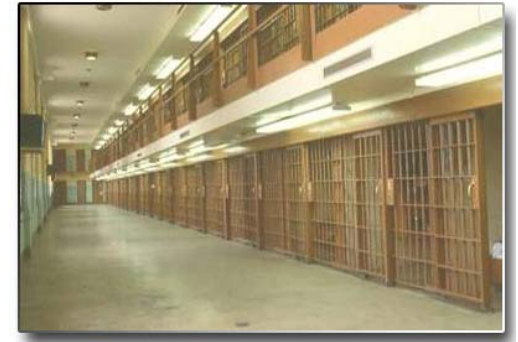

A CAUSE FOR ABSTINENCE



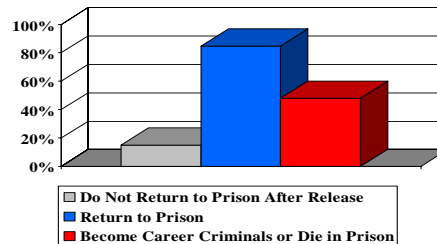

A QUESTION OF CHARACTER
